Steelers Defeat Cardinals With 34 Seconds Left

The Arizona Cardinals were in the Super Bowl against the Steelers on Sunday night, February 1, 2009. The final score was 27-23. The linebacker James Harrison, the N.F.L.'s defensive player of the year, intercepted Kurt Warner's pass at the Steelers' goal line and returned the ball 100 yards for a touchdown. This amazing play was the final play of the first half of the game. As the final seconds of the second half ticked away, Ben Roethlisberger, quarterback of the Steelers, put the Steelers ahead of the Cardinals with a pass to Santonio Holmes in the end zone. Roethlisberger completed 21 of 30 passes for 256 yards. Santonio Holmes, the game's most valuable player, caught 9 passes for 131 yards. It was the Steelers 6th Super Bowl victory, the most of any team in National Football League history.



You should stay away from him because he is going to hurt you.


Dear Travis


