

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT SERVICES - Terry Children's Center

The Terry Children's Center (TCC) is located in New Castle, DE and serves children age twelve (12) and younger.

TCC offers three primary programs: residential treatment services, day treatment services and crisis respite services. TCC educational services are provided through the DSCYF Division of Management Support Services.

The following services are provided within the same physically secured building:

- **Residential Treatment Services:** TCC residential services support up to 10 children. Children in the residential treatment center (RTC) attend school onsite and are mixed with the day treatment population. In addition to attending school with the day treatment students, the children in the RTC also participate in a broad range of school related activities. The RTC operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- **Day Treatment Services:** TCC day treatment services serve up to 32 children, in addition to 10 RTC children. Day treatment programming consists of educational programming, a variety of therapeutic services (individual, family and group therapy, medication management, creative arts therapy) and recreational activities. The day treatment program is operational Monday through Fridays (except on holidays). The day program hours are from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., with occasional appointments before or after school, as well as in-home or community based counseling appointments, home school consultations, etc.
- **Crisis Stabilization Unit:** TCC Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) serves up to six children or adolescents at any time. The youth are admitted to the CSU either through the Division's crisis intervention program or by direct admittance authorized through the Division's managed care teams. The CSU services are optimally designed for a three-day length of stay. During this time, the crisis intervention team or managed care team works with the youth and family to return the youth to his/her home as quickly as possible. TCC provides child-youth supervision/management as well as psychiatric evaluation and medication management if appropriate.
