<p>EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES K-3: The K-3 program is a collaborative effort between the Department of Services for Children, Youth and Their Families (DSCYF), Division of Family Services, the Department of Education (DOE), and participating public school districts. Participation in the program is for children attending kindergarten through third grade and their families. The K-3 Early Intervention Program addresses issues within the home that affect performance in the classroom.
