

How This Translates in DPBHS

- Under the draft version of the billing manual, there will be columns:
 - Sub-Svc ID = sub-service ID
 - Service/Sub-Service = Current levels of care and sub-services in narrative form
 - Proposed Codes – are the proposed CPT/HCPCS/Rev Codes to be billed
 - Description – basic description of the codes
 - PBH Billing Manual Definition – what will be included in the revised Billing Manual

FY 2014 Governor's Recommended Budget

The Governor included three major initiatives in his FY 2014 Recommended Budget for the Division of Prevention and Behavioral Health Services, which was presented to the Joint Finance Committee on February 14.

- \$2,225,000 for Expanded After School and Summer Services for Youth; Program to include:
 - Suicide Awareness
 - Anti-Bullying
 - Substance Abuse Prevention
 - Awareness Training for adults serving youth
 - Curriculum with arts & nature
- \$3,300,000 for Early Access to Behavioral Health Services
 - Expand the Behavioral Health Consultant program in the Middle Schools
 - Psychiatric Consultations for Primary Care Physicians
 - Tele-psychiatry
- \$262,700 Supporting Healthy Minds Strengthened In-State Treatment Centers:
 - Silver Lake Treatment Center (Middletown) to consolidate locations, improving service delivery, and access for families.
